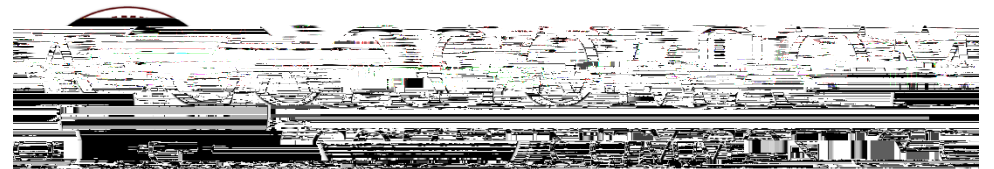

Providing tuition discounts.

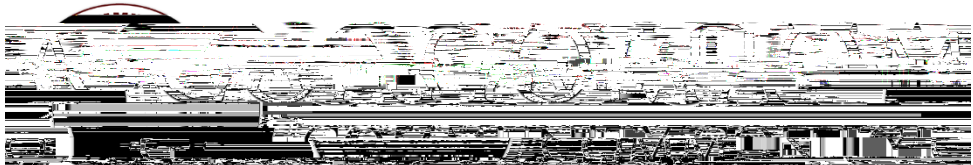
Technology hardware to students, such as laptops or tablets, or covering the added cost of technology fees.

Vaccination Incentives

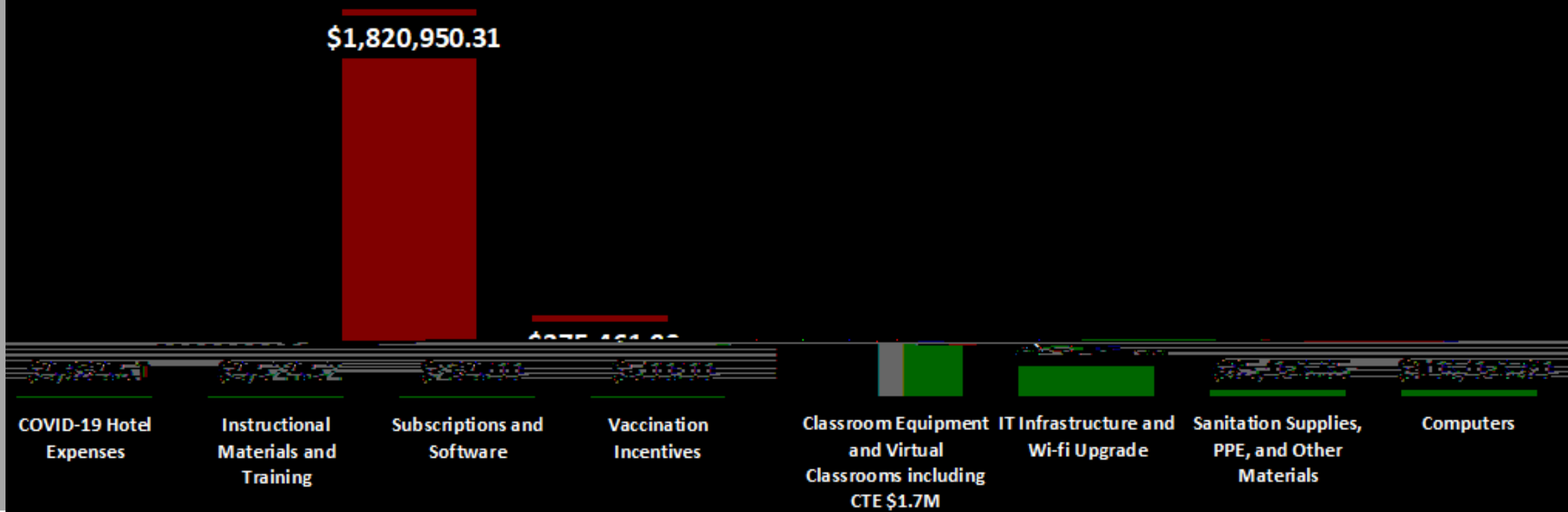

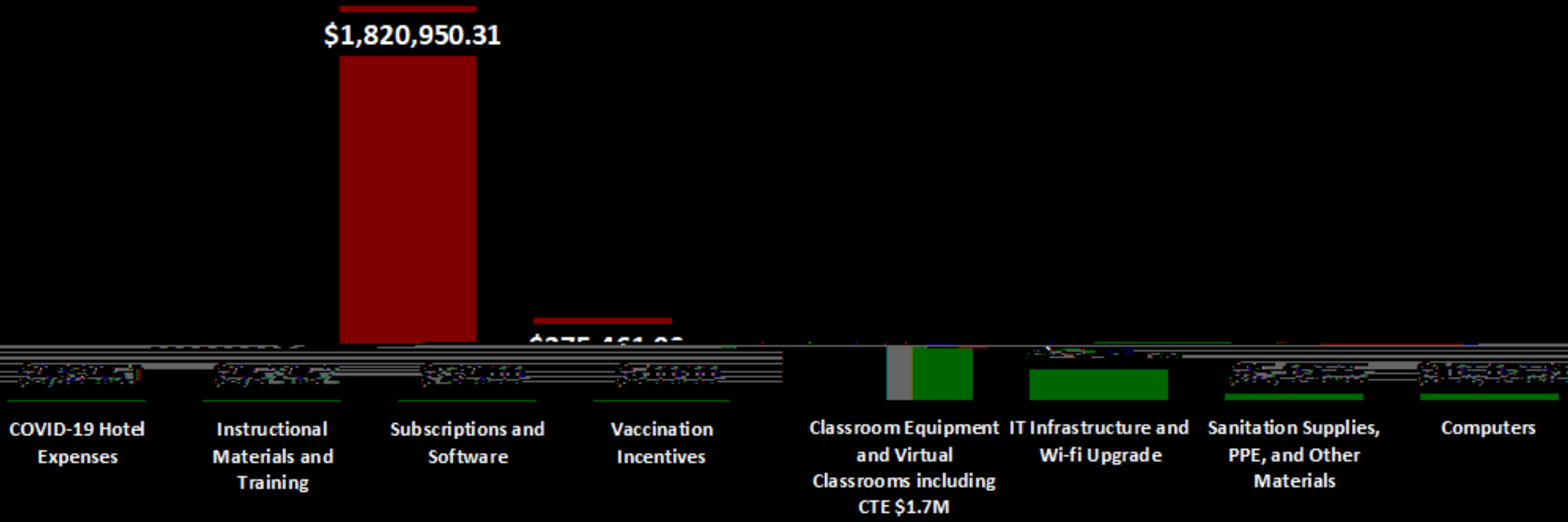
ENCUMBERED EXPENDITURES BY CATEGORY

Outstanding Purchase Orders (POs) As of February 2022



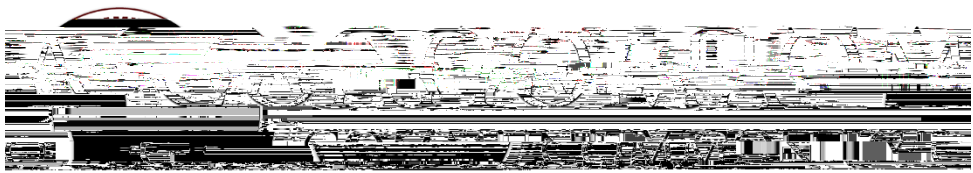
ENCUMBERED EXPENDITURES BY CATEGORY

Outstanding Purchase Orders (POs) As of February 2022

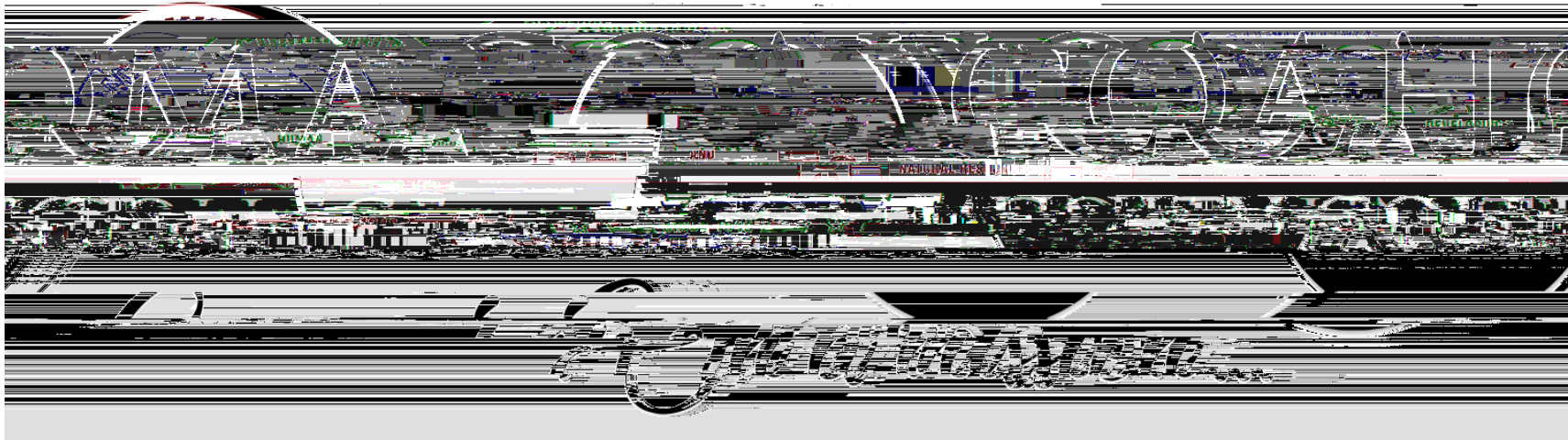


Outstanding Purchase Orders Report (Encumbered) as February 25, 2022
